What is the Electoral Roll?

The Electoral Roll is the official membership list of the Church of England. Each Parish has its own Electoral Roll, and anyone over the age of sixteen is entitled to be included if they have been baptised and either live in the parish or regularly attend services at one of our worship centres.

In practical terms, being on the Electoral Roll is a sign of your commitment to the Church Family here in Cromer and of your willingness to give and to work to realise the vision we believe God has given us. Being on the Roll also gives the right to vote at the Annual Parochial Church Meeting when Parochial Church Council members and others are elected and, after being on the Roll for six months, to stand as a candidate in those elections.

What do we expect from those on the Electoral Roll?

The summary of our 2025 Vision says: “Our vision for 2025 is to see hundreds of lives transformed by Jesus with a vibrant church community of 1,000 people as we release missional disciples and intentionally invest in Families, Children and Youth.” We hope that all those on the Electoral Roll will be fully behind this vision, and willing to do all they can to make it a reality.
